HIGH SCHOOL GPA VS BRIGHT FUTURES GPA

- Unweighted high school GPA calculates every high school credit attempted.
- Weighted high school GPA calculates every high school credit attempted with extra points for honors, AP and DE courses.
- Bright Futures GPA is weighted.
 However, only core academics and
 foreign language courses factor into the
 Bright Futures GPA.
- Bright Futures GPA and High School GPA are rarely the same.





FINANCIAL AID

- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
 - EVERYONE should apply in early October
 - Could get free money to help pay for college
 - Many ways to get assistance filing a FAFSA through county planned events
- Private Scholarships
 - Check the SCHS Naviance Site-new scholarships added every week
 - Education Foundation of Osceola offers lots of scholarships-Application available in November.

This application will also qualify students for other state scholarships



Must know social security number to apply



It is 100% the responsibility of the student to ensure that they have taken the SAT or ACT, applied for Bright Futures and completed the required community service

Scholarship	Bright Futures GPA	Test Scores	Community Service
FAS	3.5	SAT: Critical Reading+Math= 1290 OR ACT: 29	100 Hours
FMS	3.0	SAT: Critical Reading+Math= 1170 OR ACT: 26	75 Hours



SAT/ACT TEST PREP

- Free School Day SAT October 16 for all Seniors
- SAT suggests using Khan Academy-free online test prep program
- Students can come to Career Center most Wednesdays after school from 1:30-2:30 or during PAWs:
 - Get assistance with college applications, registering for SAT/ACT, and scholarship applications



APPLICATIONS

4 Year College Applications

- Check school deadlines- State Universities deadlines posted in Career Center (UF/FSU due Nov 1)
- Submit fee, test scores, transcript and essay
- All online applications

2 year College

- Apply by January
- Have a Valencia Transitions Counselor at SCHS to assist with application on Mondays and Tuesdays


Military: Ongoing

- Take the ASVAB
 - Offered at SCHS twice per year- details sent out through REMIND

Trade or Technical Schools

- Apply in the Spring or Summer
- Osceola Technical College: most programs apply in March
