Most post-secondary opportunities require a basic understanding of specific apps and programs. Laptops are considered an essential student resource, like textbooks and or any other school provided educational resource.

This school year every student at Neptune Middle School will be provided with a Dell Laptop, a charger, and a hardcase. If needed, internet hotspots are available for students as well. Students have been given several forms; this letter, a flyer with general information about their device, and a "borrower's agreement". Both sides of the borrower's agreement must be filled out.

All students will be required to take their laptops home. Students will need to bring their laptops back to school fully charged ready for class. All student laptops will be monitored during school and home use. Students are expected to secure all devices checked out to them in their provided case to prevent them from being damaged.
