DURING THE LUNCH HOUR

DESIGNATED LUNCH AREAS: Cafeterias and courtyard

- **If in courtyard need to stay inside the maroon/gold lines. If you are on the gold side of the lines, you are out of area.*
- *All buildings are off limits without a pass from a teacher.*
- ***Any student found out of area during lunch will be given a consequence***

After PAWS

- Gym is open to play basketball or sit in bleachers
- Weight room is open provided supervision

ATHLETICS/ROTC/AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

- Once a student has made a sports team, ROTC, dance team, band, chorus, etc. they must maintain passing grades and adequate attendance in ALL of their classes
- If at any time their grades fall below passing in a class, the student may be placed on a one week probation period to bring their grade up to passing (probation period is one time per sport)
 - If after the probation period the grade is still not passing than the student will not participate until the grade is no longer an F (the student may practice at the discretion of the coach)
- If a student reaches a total of 35 missed class periods in one marking period the student may not participate until the start of the next marking period.
- **ALL STUDENTS** and their parents will sign this agreement upon making a sports team, ROTC, dance, etc.

SAGGY PANTS/SPANDEX

- Pants must be worn at the waist, and may not be worn low enough where underwear or skin may be seen.
- Remember the underwear/bra rule!
- If a student's pants are seen being worn below the waist, the student will receive a **detention** for the 1st offense, and **ISS** for the 2nd offense, along with being issued a zip-tie from the dean's office for the day

NO SPANDEX or YOGA PANTS EVER

(including dress down days)

HAIR

- Mohawks are to be no longer than 3 inches
- No unnatural hair color will be permitted.
- A student with unnatural hair color will be given 1 day to fix it. If after 1 day the color is not fixed, the student will be placed in ISS until it is dyed back to a natural color.

FACIAL PIERCINGS

- Students are allowed to wear ONE stud or clear spacer on their face (*NO bars, hoops, etc.*)
- If a student is caught with more than one piercing or something other than a spacer/stud, the piercing will be confiscated and the student will receive a Wednesday detention.
- If the student is caught for a 2nd offense, the student will be assigned to ISS.

CELL PHONES



Students are allowed to use cell phones before school, during lunch, during transitions, and after school. Students are not permitted to use their cell phones or other electronic devices in the classroom **unless teacher gives special permission (BYOD)**.

Headphones and devices must be off and put away before entering class. We are allowing the use of phones during transitions (only one ear bud in-this is a state statute), so there is no reason to use your device in class.

If you post it (Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, Periscope, etc.) we WILL find out about it and a consequence will follow

NO FOOD OR DRINKS IN BUILDINGS

Only water in a clear plastic container is allowed in classrooms all other items will be confiscated and disposed of

If caught using vending machines during class time- out of area- Administrative Detention- NO EATING DURING CLASS TIME

Eating during PAWS must be in a classroom with a teacher

No Birthday items on campus i.e. balloons, cake, flowers, etc. All items will be held in the front office



BELL SCHEDULE/TARDIES

- ✓ Each student is **permitted 3 tardies to school** every 9 weeks. The **4th** tardy will be an administrative detention. The **5th** tardy and on, students will get their lunch pass revoked, ISS, and Academic Obligation Hours
- ✓ **Each tardy to class** will receive an administrative detention- you are tardy if you are not in the classroom or have a pass
- ✓ **Absent 10+ days** will result in mandatory parent meeting and medical only designation. In addition, you will **lose access to participation in extracurricular activities such as athletics, fine arts, clubs, etc.**
- ✓ Field Trip permission forms will be reviewed by administration- grades and attendance will be considered in order to attend

There is PLENTY of time (5 minutes) to get to class on time

CONSEQUENCES

Lunch Detention, Wednesday Detention, ISS, Out of School Suspension

- Lunch Detention= First half of lunch in room 1-200 (students must be on time and have something to do)
- Fighting= minimum 3-5 days OSS
- Running to a fight or appears as though running to a fight or videotaping a fight= minimum 3 days of OSS
- Yelling/Verbal Confrontation that disrupts campus= minimum 3 days of OSS
- Drugs (vape pen), Alcohol, Weapons- arrested and expelled

LOCKERS/PE

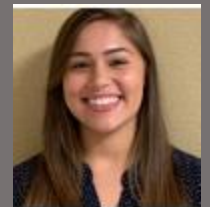

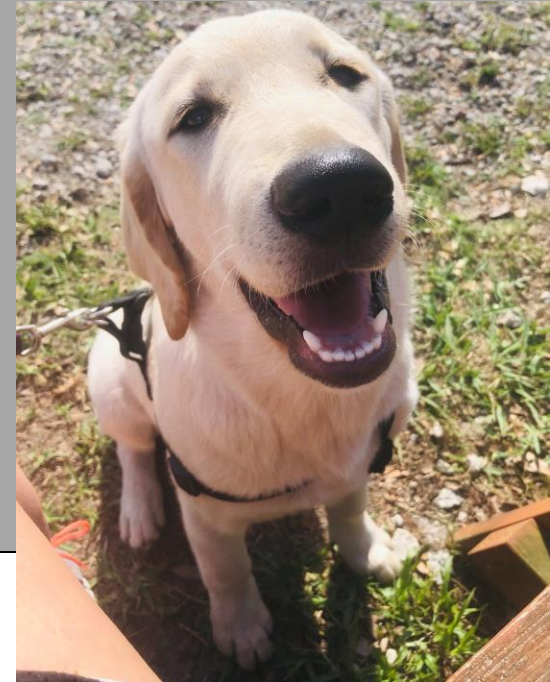

- ✓ DOB is 9/20/2018 (10 months old)
- ✓ Goldadore (1/2 Golden Retriever, 1/2 Labrador)
- ✓ Only EAD at a high school in the county
- ✓ Named after Michael P. Murphy, Navy SEAL that served in Afghanistan and was the 1st Navy Seal since Vietnam to receive the Medal of Honor
- ✓ In another year he will have dual classifications as both a service dog and therapy dog
